**Day Shelter:** 6:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday-Friday

**\*\*Extended Winter Hours:** 6:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday-Friday\*\*

**Resource Center:** 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday-Friday

The campus is open to anyone, including pets. The Day Shelter offers breakfast and lunch, showers, access to computers, phones, mail service, barbershop, and access to classes, activities, and services. Services include the Oklahoma County social services, health clinics, Legal Aid, payee services, mental health care, employment programs, DHS, STI testing, veterans' programs, and other services. Service times vary.

The Homeless Alliance also offers job opportunities by becoming a vendor of the Curbside Chronicle, OKC’s premier street paper.

This is your chance for a hand up, not a handout.

Training is held every Tuesday and Thursday at 9 am. Only the first five people in line will be accepted for that day’s training.
